INFORMATION, TERMS, STANDARDS

WHAT — The Merchants of Kirklin organization is pleased to announce its first annual art fair, featuring the works of area artists and artisans. Each item on display and for sale must be the participating artist's original creation and production for which the artist owns exclusive rights. Mechanically and mass-produced copies of originals must be displayed as such. Working exhibits are welcome and encouraged.

SHOW HOURS — The show hours correspond with the Kirklin merchants' hours of operation: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday, July 19; and noon to 5 p.m., Sunday, July 20.

STANDARDS — It is the intent of the Merchants of Kirklin organization to host an event that celebrates area artists and their high-quality, original works that visitors of all ages can enjoy. Art pieces that feature subject matter of a violent, sexual and obscene nature will not be welcome at the Kirklin Art Fair. The art fair sponsor holds the right to reject content that it considers explicitly inappropriate.

BOOTH SPACE & LOCATION — Artists will be allotted a space, approximately 36 square feet (6 feet x 6 feet). The location of the artist's space will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis during the set up, 8 a.m. to 10 a.m., Saturday, July 19, 2014. Each exhibitor is expected to provide his/her own setup, not to exceed 6-feet x 6-feet.

FEES — A \$5 fee will be assessed per space, payable when the artist's application is submitted. The fee is nonrefundable, unless Kirklin Merchants organization deems the artist's works unacceptable.

HOW TO APPLY — Complete the application form and submit it with the \$5 registration fee by mail to "Kirklin Art Fair, P.O. Box 128, Kirklin, IN 46050" OR via email to janisthor@aol.com **by June 1, 2014**. With the application form, please include photos (or JPEGs) of three examples of your work that you plan to exhibit at the fair. The application fee may be paid by cash or check.

LIABILITY — The Merchants of Kirklin organization is not responsible or liable for injury, theft, loss or damage to property before, during or after the art fair's hours. Exhibitors are responsible for the security and safety of their works at all times, including the overnight hours between 5 p.m. Saturday, July 19, and noon Sunday, July 20.

OTHER —

- Participating artists must be 18 years of age and over.
- Participants are responsible for setting up their exhibit spaces between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m., Saturday, July 19, 2014, and for cleaning up their exhibit space after the show closes at 5 p.m., Sunday, July 20.
- Participants are responsible for providing their own furnishings, supplies and materials.
- The Merchants of Kirklin group reserves the right to remove unsuitable artwork (see "Standards" above).
- The fair will not be canceled, suspended, or postponed due to inclement weather.
